DID YOU KNOW?

Bailey's Lake was named in honor of William T. Bailey (1842-1914), who owned a successful lumber mill on the north shore of the neighboring Silver Lake. Today, you can find a statue of Bailey in Rotary Park, a few hundred feet from where his sawmill was built in 1897.
